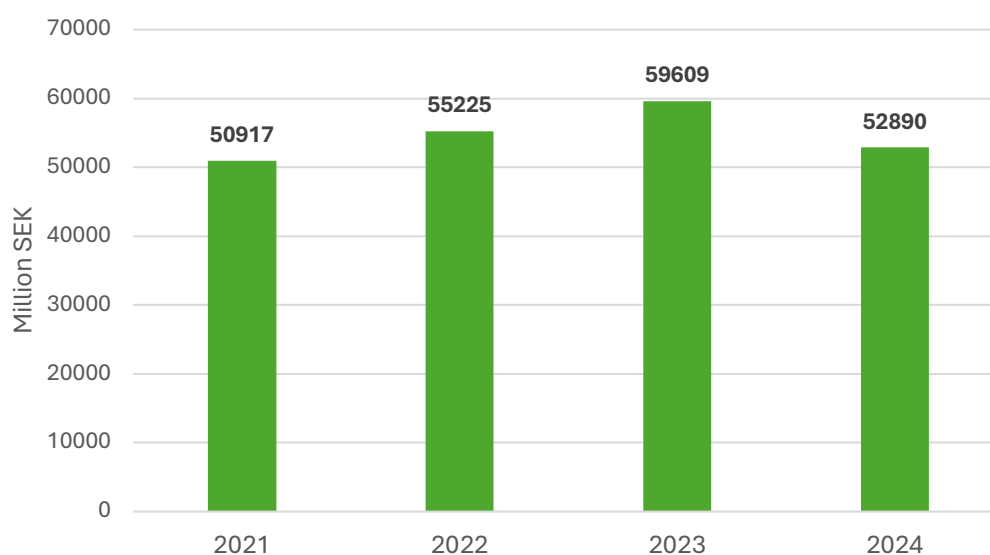

Methodology for assessing SRHR-share of total ODA

The Deutsche Stiftung Weltbevölkerung (DSW) methodology

The first methodology applied in this report is based on the *Donors Delivering for SRHR* report published in 2025 by Deutsche Stiftung Weltbevölkerung (DSW) (1). Based on the comprehensive definition of SRHR from the Guttmacher-Lancet report and the International Conference on Population and Development (ICPD), the methodology applies imputed percentages to selected OECD DAC CRS purpose codes to estimate total donor funding to SRHR (covering both bilateral and multilateral disbursements) for the years 2021 to 2023 (see Appendix I). While the selected percentages for sector codes remain stable over the years, the SRHR share of core support for multilaterals varies and is estimated annually based on the proportion of each multilateral's disbursements that benefit SRHR (1). In this report we apply the DSW shares for 2021-2023. For 2024, the shares for the most recent year available (2023) were applied.

The Swedish Ministry for Foreign Affairs and Sida methodology

The second analysis in this report is based on the methodology applied by the Swedish Ministry for Foreign affairs and Sida (hereinafter referred to as the "Sida/UD methodology"), The most recent report based on this methodology is *Sweden's Development Assistance for Health in 2023* (2). In this report, Sweden's development assistance for SRHR is estimated based on disbursement data from two sources: the Ministry for Foreign Affairs and The Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (Sida) statistical databases. Similar to DSW, Sweden's analysis applies fixed percentages for selected OECD DAC CRS purpose codes for aid from Sida and for core support to multilaterals to estimate the SRHR share (see Appendix I). The share of Swedish core support to multilateral organizations allocated to SRHR is estimated based on data from each organization indicating the proportion of non-earmarked funding directed toward SRHR (2). Estimation of bilateral support follows Sida's new statistical definition of SRHR aid developed in 2022. The Sida methodology uses a selected set of sector codes that align with the components of the Guttmacher-Lancet Commission's definition of SRHR. The percentages assigned to the selected sector codes is the estimated average share of SRHR-aid within each code (2). In this report, the assigned percentages were utilized for 2021-2023 and the most recent percentages (from year 2023) were applied for 2024.

Data source and revision of data undertaken by Sida

The aid disbursement data used in this report was retrieved from Openaid, a public website that publishes and visualizes official statistics on Swedish development assistance (3). The data for this report was collected in July 2025 and includes all agencies who has disburse Swedish ODA. This differs from the data sources utilized in the report *Sweden's Development Assistance for Health in 2023*, which relied solely on disbursement data from Sida and the Ministry for Foreign Affairs (UD) (2). Together, Sida and UD were responsible for nearly all Swedish ODA between 2021 and 2024 (approximately 97.4 %) (4). Therefore, although the data source in this report differs from that used in *Sweden's Development Assistance for Health in 2023*, the differences with our assessment of total SRHR aid are small and do not affect the overall conclusions regarding the SRHR share of Swedish ODA. Furthermore, according to information obtained in an email exchange with Sida, the differences are not only due to the inclusion of multiple responsible agencies but may also be explained by the fact that data on Openaid is continuously updated.

Another factor that create differences is that Sida conducted a quality assurance effort since last year, that resulted in retroactive adjustments to Openaid's reported total disbursements for the years 2021 to 2023. According to information from Sida, these adjustments were made to ensure data consistency across different publications and involved corrections for certain authorities, such as the Swedish Research Council ("Vetenskapsrådet") and the Government Offices ("Regeringskansliet"). These revisions should be considered when comparing the results of this report with analyses based on data collected in 2024 or earlier, including the author's report from 2024 and the report *Sweden's Development Assistance for Health in 2023*. The differences in total ODA year 2021 to 2023 before and after Sida's quality assurance effort are presented in Appendix II, which demonstrate data collected by the author from Openaid in July 2024 and July 2025.

To assess the impact of Sida's quality assurance effort on the estimation of SRHR funding, the latest DSW methodology was applied to data collected from Openaid by the author in July 2024 and July 2025. As expected, the amount of Swedish ODA to SRHR differs slightly in the results, depending on if the data was collected before and after Sida's revision (< 21

million SEK/year, see Appendix II). However, the SRHR share of Swedish ODA in percentages are nearly identical with only minor differences ($< 0,05\%$, see Appendix II). This indicates that although Sida's quality assurance effort led to some differences in the reported amounts of Swedish ODA for SRHR, it does not significantly affect our estimates of the SRHR share.

Figure 2. The amount of Swedish ODA for SRHR according to the *DSW-methodology* year 2021-2024 in million SEK.

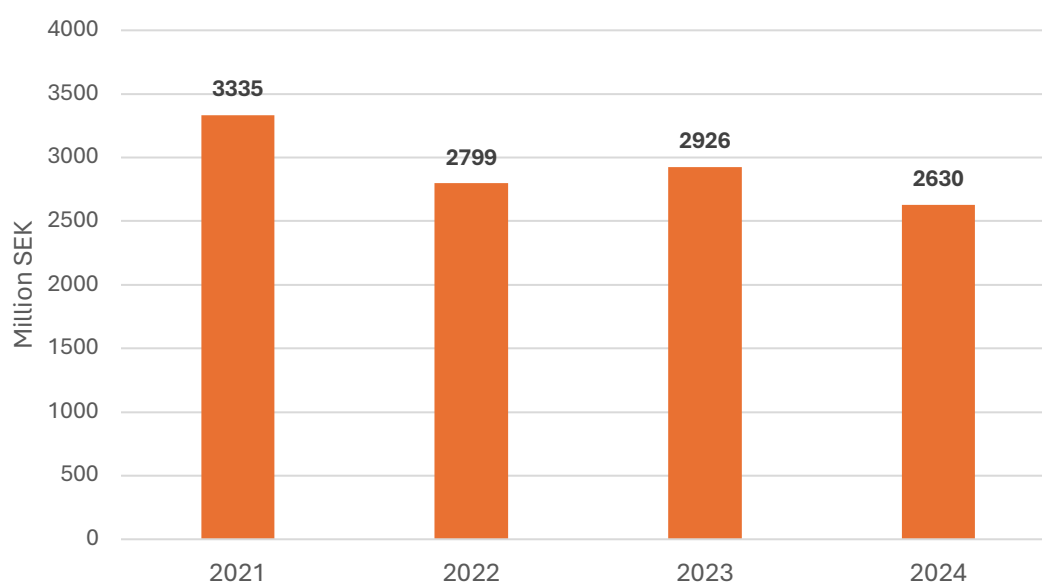
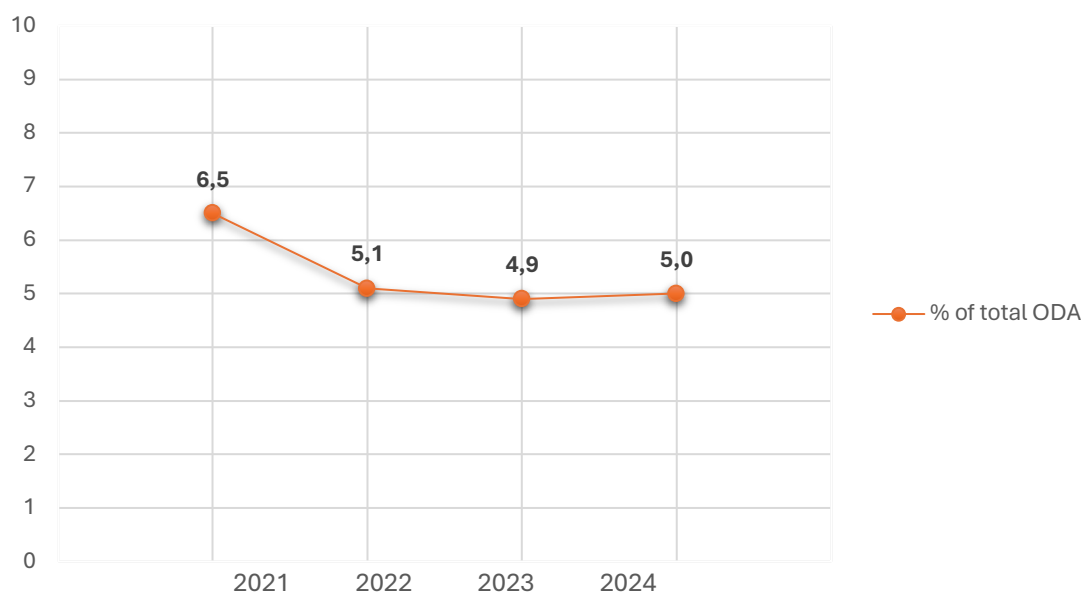


Figure 3. The SRHR-share of Swedish ODA using the *DSW-methodology* 2021-2024 in percent.



The SRHR-share of Swedish ODA using the Sida/UD methodology

The estimates presented here are based on data retrieved from Openaid in July 2025, after Sida's quality assurance effort had been implemented. In contrast to *Sweden's Development Assistance for Health in 2023*, which relied solely on disbursement data from Sida and the Ministry for Foreign Affairs (UD), this report draws on total ODA from all responsible agencies as presented in Openaid (see section "Data source and revision of data undertaken by Sida for further information).

Figure 4. The amount of Swedish ODA for SRHR according to the *Sida/UD methodology* 2021-2024 in million SEK.

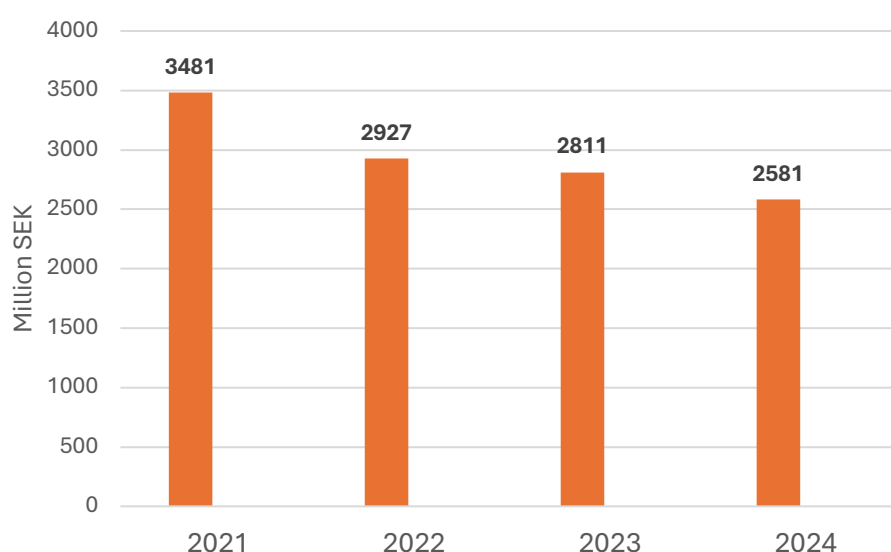
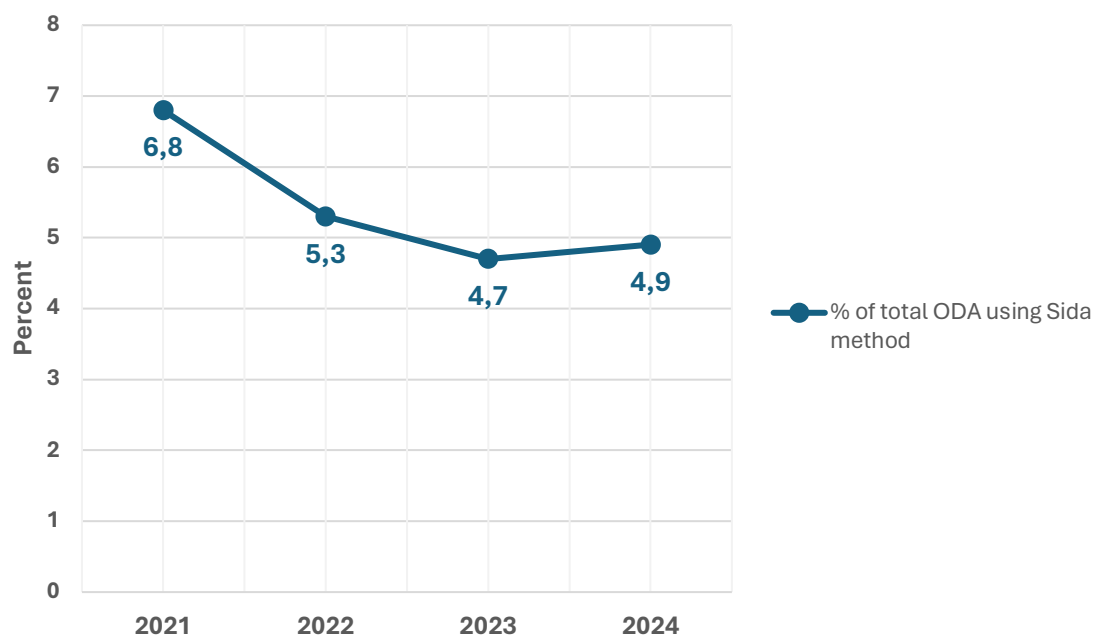


Figure 5. The SRHR-share of Swedish ODA according to the *Sida/UD methodology* 2021-2024 in percent.

Figure 6. The amount of Swedish ODA for SRHR using the Sida/UD methodology and DSW methodology 2021-2024 in million SEK.

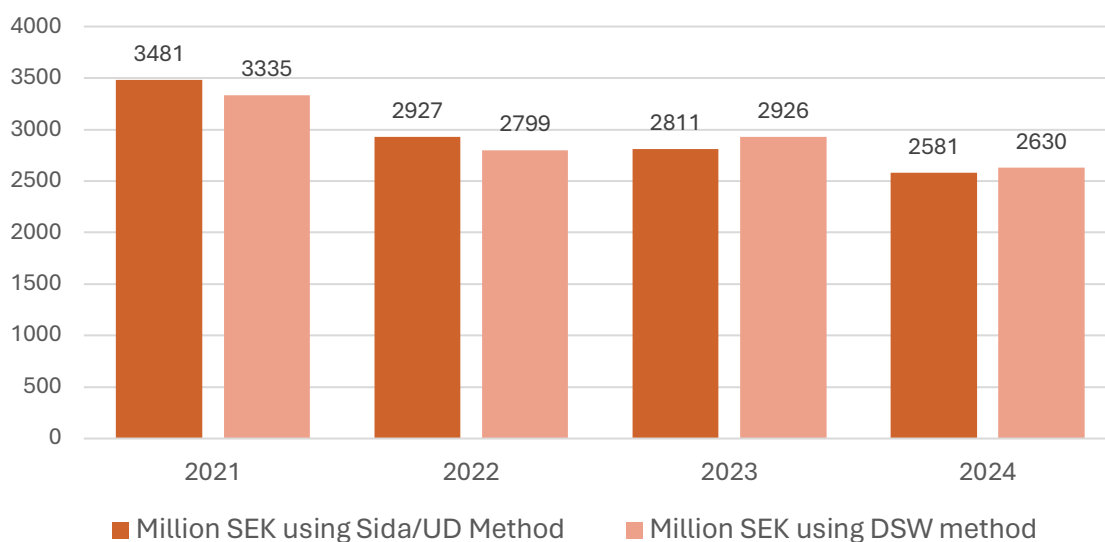
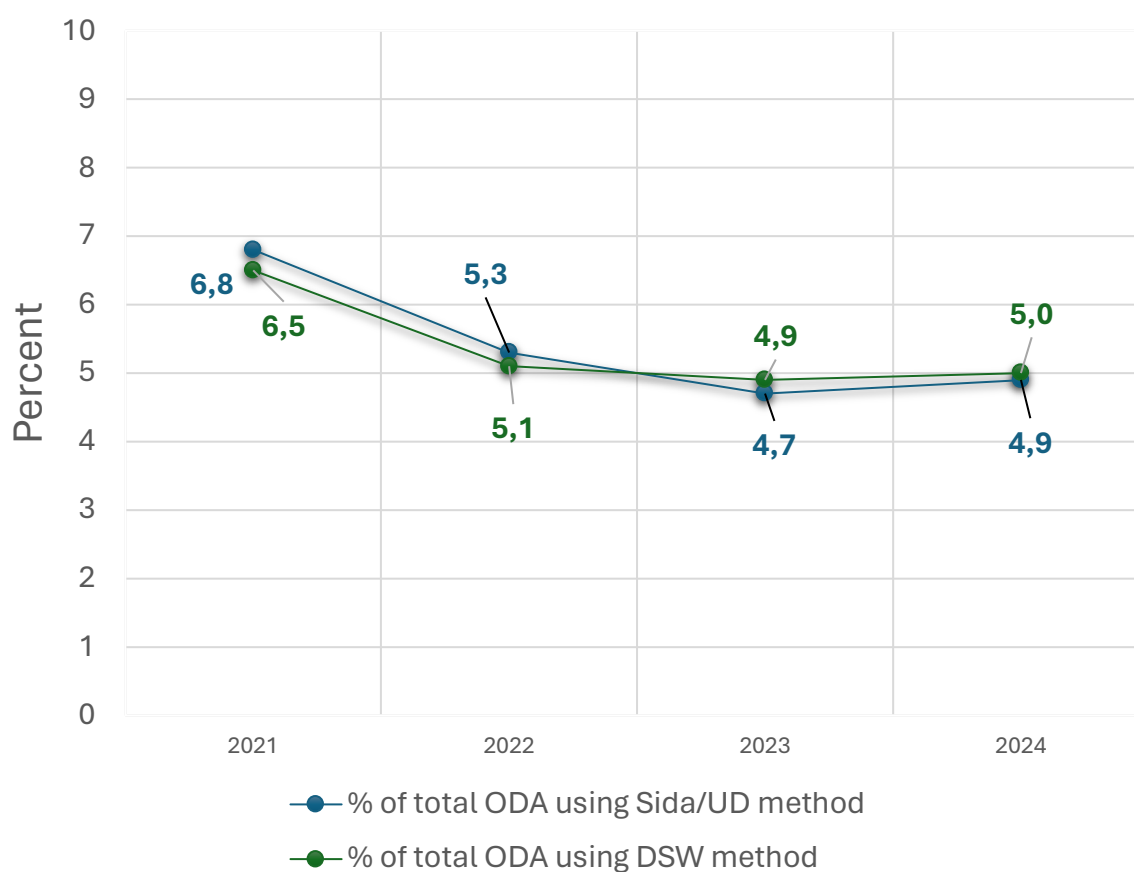


Figure 7. The SRHR-share of Swedish ODA using the Sida/UD methodology and DSW methodology 2021-2024 in percent.

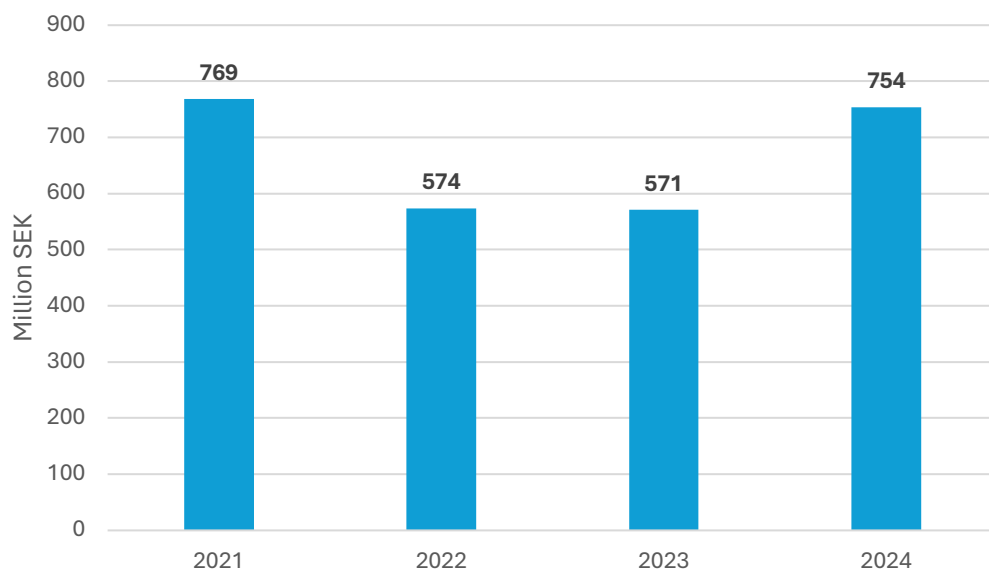

Figure 8. Total disbursements for earmarked support to UNFPA 2021-2024 in million SEK

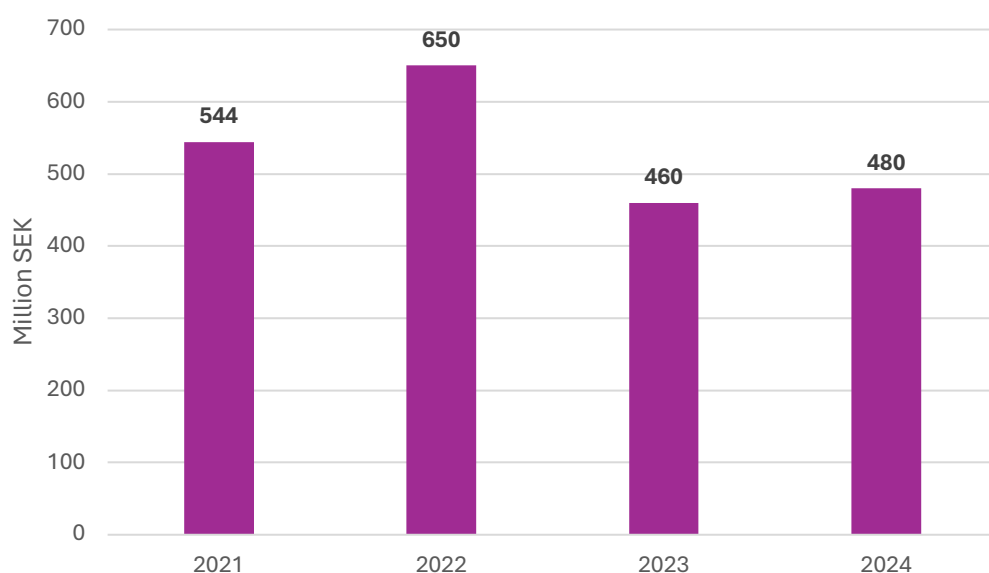

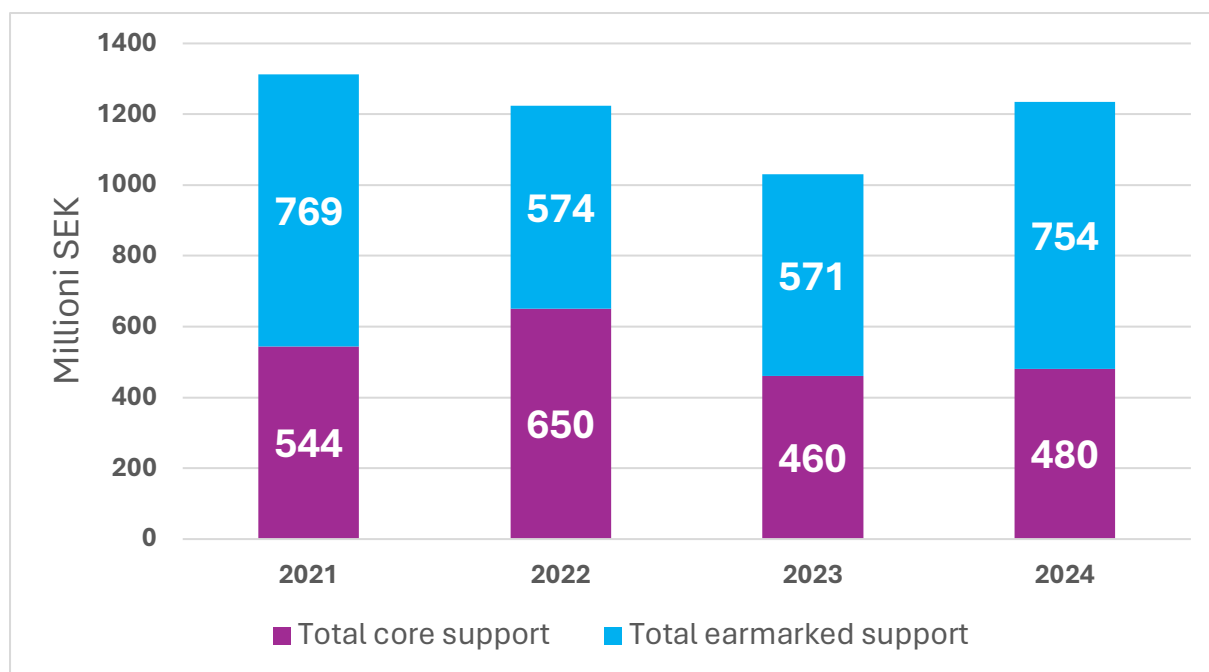

Figure 10. Total disbursements of core support and earmarked support to UNFPA 2021-2024 in million SEK

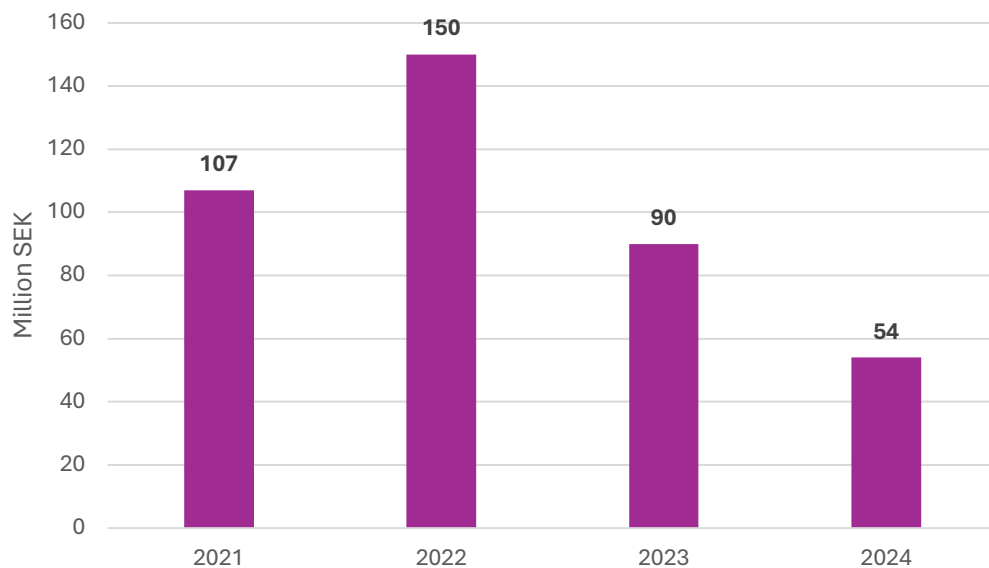

Figure 11. Total disbursements of core support to UN WOMEN 2021-2024 in million SEK

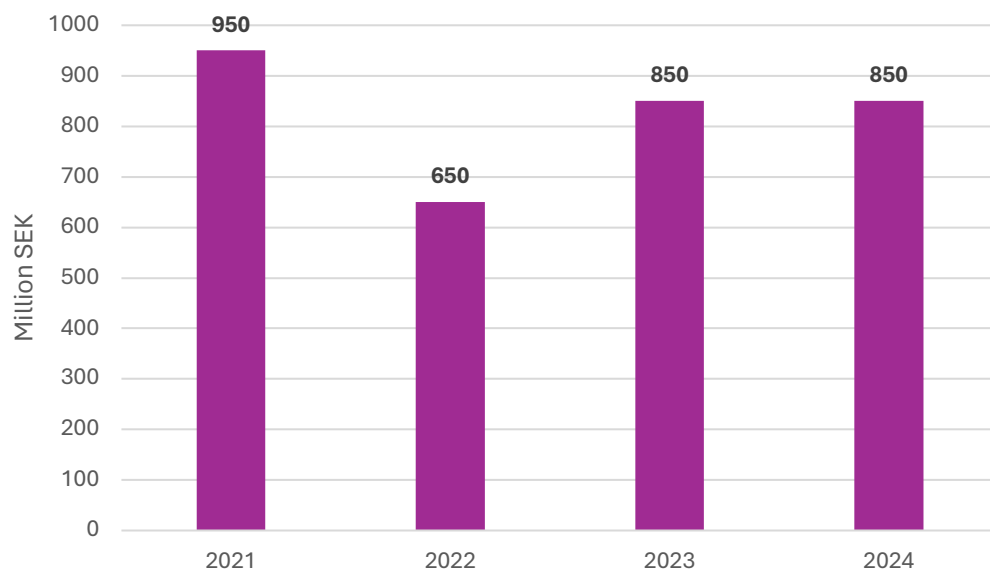

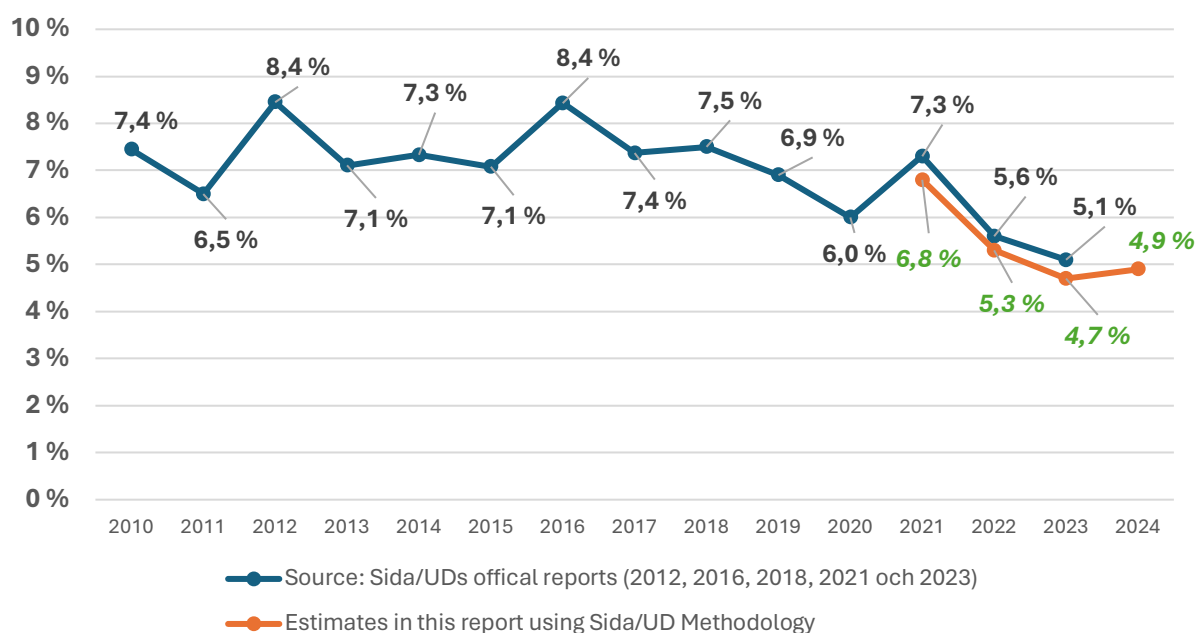


Figure 13. Swedish SRHR ODA as share of total ODA 2010-2024 (%)

Figure 13 shows the development of the SRHR share of total development assistance from 2010-2024 based on information from official reports combined with the estimates in this report.
